

COMPLIANCE OF UGC REGULATION ON CURBING THE MEANACE OF RAGGING IN

NOTABLES



- · Abetment to ragging;
- · Criminal conspiracy to rag;
- · Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;

HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION

- · Public nuisance created during ragging;
- · Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- . Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- Wrongful restraint;
- · Wrongful confinement;
- · Use of criminal force;
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences;
- · Extortion; Criminal trespass; Offences against property; Criminal intimidation;
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim (s);
- · Physical or psychological humiliation;
- · All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging"

2. Measures for prohibition of ragging at the institution level:-

- The institution shall strictly observe the provisions of the Act of the Central Government and the State Governments, if any, or if enacted, considering ng ragging as a cognizable o ence under the law on a par with rape and other atrocities against women and ill-treatment of persons belonging to the SC/ST, and prohibiting ragging in all its forms in all institutions.
- Ragging in all its forms shall be totally banned in the entire institution, including its departments, constituent
 units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen, etc) whether located within the campus or
 outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private.
- The institution shall take strict action against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging.

3. Punishments At the Institution Level:

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- · Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- · Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- · Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- · Cancellation of admission
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters or 2 years
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period
- · Fine ranging between Rupees 25.000/-and Rupees 1 lokh;
- Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective Punishment.






